East Lindsey residents can now renew or subscribe online for their green waste collections for the upcoming 2026/27 season.

Sign up online via the council's website

www.e-lindsey.gov.uk/greenwaste

This is quick and easy, allowing you to do it at your own convenience.

For an annual fee of £55.00, you will receive 21 green waste collections.

NB: The Council will not be able to process telephone payments until Monday 19 January 2026.

Current subscribers to the Green Waste collection service must re-subscribe by Sunday 22 February to ensure all 21 collections are carried out. While residents can still subscribe after this date, the start date may be delayed, and the full 21 collections cannot be guaranteed, though the cost will remain the same.

For current subscribers, the final collections for the 2025/26 season will take place during the week ending Sunday 29 March 2026. The subscription period for 2026/27 will begin the week commencing Monday 30 March 2026.

Residents who subscribe by Sunday 22 February will receive a letter with full details, a collection calendar, and a sticker for their bin(s).





NOTES FROM THE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON THURSDAY 04 DECEMBER 2025

There were two members of the public. One came along to speak about the over development of the village, but understood that there is nothing the Parish Council can do although it does keep trying. The second member of the public was attending in reply to queries regarding co-option. It was agreed that this person could join the Parish Council as there had been no other interest.

Mr M Boseley signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office and joined the Councillors

Present: Cllrs Boseley, Hopkins, Burton, Sherriff, Jones and Edwards (Chairman)

Apologies: received from Cllrs Pocklington and Pritchard and Dist Cllr Jones

Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest

Reports from representatives on outside bodies

County Cllr Hume was not present.

Dist Cllr Jones was not present, but reported that the grant application form had been sent to ELDC.

Dist Cllr Ashton was not present.

Planning applications received

03429/25/FUL - Mr & Mrs C McKinlay - Erection of a dwelling and pole barn to replace existing static caravan and shed on site at Charnwood, West Fen Lane - **SUPPORT**

03436/25/OUT - Mr K Holland - Outline erection of 3 properties at Land off Main Road - **OBJECT**

Concerns were raised regarding the flooding of this land and the access onto the Main Road

03612/25/RES - Mr & Mrs L Brittain - Reserved matters relating to the erection of 22 dwellings (outline permission S/169/00087/23) at Land rear of Longfields, Main Road - **OBJECT**

Flooding is an existing issue on this site, conditions are required to take this into consideration.

Planning Decisions received

The appeal against the refusal of planning ref S/169/00145/25 at The Beeches, Main Road has been dismissed.

The works to the footways at Horbling Lane are creating vehicles to churn up the grass verges on the opposite side of the road. The glass has not been replaced in the defibrillator box. Parking on the footpath and the grass verges at Main Road is an issue.

Paving at the bench at Horbling Lane/Main Road

A quote to have the work done has been sought in preparation for the budget. The paving will be ‘council’ slabs and will also be placed under the seat, it was resolved to ask the contractor to carry out this work.

Christmas Event 2025

The event was very well attended, the memory tree was well used, but it was cold in Church. The lights were put up by a new team who rallied round at the last minute to help. For Christmas 2026 the pathway needs to be swept, ask for the heating to be on in Church and have a microphone for announcements. £100.00 was received in donations, this has been split between the church and the Hundleby Choir who performed for us again this year.

Play Area

The new bins cannot be ordered until the grant has been approved.

Cycle route from Stickford to Sibsey Northlands

Two copies of the proposed cycle route have been passed to County Cllr Hume, nothing further has been heard yet.

Handyman

The Handyman will be self-employed and hold public liability insurance. Duties to be performed include: Emptying the play area bins and checking play area equipment; keeping the cemetery and churchyard tidy and sweeping the Church footpath; moving the 30mph signs when required; other tasks in agreement with the Parish Council and reporting any issues to the Clerk. The hours will be two hours per week and remuneration will be discussed with the applicants. Applications will be to the Clerk via email.

Draft Budget for the year ended 31 March 2027

The Clerk presented the new figures following the amendments made at the last meeting and the increase in expected spending to 31 March 2026. It was resolved to use Cemetery Reserves to pay for the repairs to the chains around the Garden of Remembrance, which have been vandalised, and the remaining reserves will be used towards the re-surfacing of the cemetery footpath. It was also resolved to have £4500 to keep in the deposit account for general reserves. The guidance is to hold up to 1½ times the amount of the annual precept in general reserves, the Parish Council currently hold £10,000. This will be built up over the coming years due to coming changes at both County and District level – more jobs may be passed to the Parish Council. With these changes made it was resolved that the precept be set at £40,000.00.
